

ASSEMBLY

Installing/Uninstalling the Debris Separator With a Compatible MILWAUKEE® Vacuum

To install/uninstall the tool onto the vacuum:


1. Centre the tool on top of the vacuum.
2. On all 4 corners, retract the clips down from the tool.
3. Clip the tool into place using the storage tie-downs on the vacuum. Ensure all corners are clipped into place.
4. To uninstall the tool, release the clips on each corner and unclip from the vacuum. Remove the tool from the vacuum.

Installing/Removing the Dust Extraction Adaptor


The dust extractor hose adaptor is used to connect the hose to a power tool in place of other dust collection, such as a dust bag.

To install the adaptor, remove any nozzles or accessories from the end of the hose. Twist the adaptor onto the hose until tight for a secure fit. To remove, reverse the procedure.


1. Unscrew hose end.



2. Remove hose end.



3. Twist on clip attachment.



Attaching the Expandable Hose

To install:

1. Remove the 47.6 mm (1-7/8") expandable hose from the top of the tool.
2. Use the expandable hose port on the vacuum with two pegs, and turn the hose clockwise to lock into place.
3. Attach the accessory to the end of the hose for the vacuuming application (optional).

To uninstall:

1. Remove the accessory from the expandable hose.
2. Turn the expandable hose anticlockwise to unlock the hose from the tool.
3. Reinstall the expandable hose onto the top of the tool.

OPERATION

Using the Debris Separator

1. Remove the multi-fit hose adaptor from the top of the tool.
2. Insert the multi-fit hose adaptor into the vacuum hose connection port of the debris separator.
3. Attach the vacuum hose to the multi-fit hose adaptor on the tool. See "Specifications".
4. Remove the expandable hose from the top of the tool.
5. Insert the expandable hose into the tool and turn clockwise to lock it into place.
6. Turn on the wet/dry vacuum, and monitor the amount of debris coming into the bottom of the separator.

Disposal of Dust

⚠WARNING To reduce the risk of injury, when working in dusty situations, wear appropriate respiratory protection or use a suitable dust extraction solution. Do not clean the debris separator with compressed air.

Regular filter cleaning of the attached vacuum and debris emptying of the separator are an essential part of regular maintenance on the unit, as a full debris collector will reduce the effectiveness of the unit. Follow carefully the user instructions associated with the attached vacuum unit. Carefully transfer the collected debris to a suitable container

with a tight-fitting lid to minimise the amount of dust that re-enters the air. Ensure minimal dust is allowed to escape when emptying unit or cleaning filters on the attached vacuum. Disposal of dust needs to be done in accordance with local regulations.

Cleaning Debris Collector

Wear suitable personal protective equipment and remove any remaining dust or debris thoroughly after the separator has been removed and appropriately handled, e.g., by using a compliant dust extraction system (Class M recommended as a minimum) in accordance with local regulations.

Unclogging the Debris Separator

⚠WARNING To reduce the risk of injury, when working in dusty situations, wear appropriate respiratory protection or use a suitable dust extraction solution. Do not clean the debris separator with compressed air.

1. Turn vacuum off.
2. Open the transparent debris door on the back of the separator.
3. Using your finger, twist both red tabs near the top of the debris door towards the door, causing the cyclone plate to lower.
4. Clear out any stuck debris from the separator.
5. Lift the separator back up and twist the red tabs back away from the door to secure it into place.
6. Close the debris door and resume work.
